- DATETIMEOFFSETFROMPARTS
- TIMEFROMPARTS

Validate Date & Time Values

- ISDATE (expression)

Modify Date & Time Values

- DATEADD (datepart , number , date)
- EOMONTH (start_date [, month_to_add])
- SWITCHOFFSET (DATETIMEOFFSET , time_zone)
- TODATETIMEOFFSET (expression , time_zone)
